



## 4 Day Kruger National Park Safari – Johannesburg to Johannesburg

A classic 4-day camping safari into the great wilderness of Kruger National Park; Game viewing some of the continent's greatest wildlife by day and sleeping under the big African sky by night. An adventure not to be missed!

**Tour Highlights:** Cheetah Rehabilitation Centre, Kruger National Park

**Group Size:** Minimum 4 / maximum 14

**Meals:** 3 Breakfasts, 2 Lunches, 3 Dinners

**Accommodation:** Accommodation is one night twin share/ en suite per 6 clients and two nights in pre erected dome tents with camp beds and shared bathrooms.

**Tour Includes:** Tour highlights, transport, accommodation, stretcher beds, sleeping mat, 2 man dome tents, meals as indicated, camping equipment, services of an English speaking driver / tour leader.

**Tour Excludes:** Visas, travel insurance, flights, airport transfers, optional activities, laundry, gratuities, passport & visa fees, meals not mentioned in the itinerary, items of a personal nature.

## ITINERARY

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### Day 1: Cheetah Rehabilitation Centre (Dx1)

Leaving behind Johannesburg we head through the scenic province of Mpumalanga and visit a cheetah rehabilitation centre, a non profit organisation, where we see the remarkable work carried out by volunteers to rehabilitate cheetah and other wildlife. Travelling onwards, we reach a private game reserve bordering the Kruger National Park and our bush lodge accommodation. These comfortable twin share, rustic rooms will ensure a good nights sleep in preparation for our early start the following day. To further help unwind enjoy the evening chatting around the fire as dinner is prepared by our crew.

### Days 2 & 3: Kruger National Park (Bx2 / Lx2 / Dx2)

We rise early and transfer into our open safari vehicles for two full days in Kruger National Park. South Africa's flagship game park the 'Kruger' has over 2 million hectares of unrivalled diversity of life forms fused with historical and archaeological sights. With cameras and binoculars at the ready, we explore the untamed wilderness on game drives, and hopefully we will see some of the Big 5 - elephant, rhino, leopard, lion and buffalo.

The Kruger is home to over 505 species of birds, 148 species of mammals and many reptiles. The impressive atmosphere of the park enables you to understand why it holds such a unique place amongst the world's great game reserves. We spend two nights here and camp within the park, staying in pre erected tents with camper beds and sleeping bag (please see 'What to Bring' section below). A typical day will be to rise early for an early game-drive, return to camp for lunch and going out again later in the afternoon. Whilst in Kruger there is usually the opportunity of taking (at own cost) an 'early evening' game drive to view nocturnal animals in their natural habitat.

**Day 4: Kruger National Park, Johannesburg (Bx1)**

We complete our Kruger Park experience with an early morning game drive in the tour mini-bus (not open vehicle) before we exit the park and make our way back to Johannesburg arriving late afternoon/ early evening.
